



MOVING TIPS

One Month Before You Move

Call a mover to obtain an estimate and schedule a moving date

If you are going to do your own packing, obtain packing cartons and begin packing

Prepare an inventory of what is being moved

Dispose of everything you will not be moving

Send friends and neighbors a note with your new address

Notify utility companies and suppliers that you wish to have the following services discontinued:

Utilities and Fuel
(Gas, electric, oil, telephone, cable, etc.)

Snow Removal

Water

Rubbish Removal

Lawn Care Service

Diaper Service

Two Weeks Before You Move

Return things borrowed including library books, etc. and collect things loaned

Arrange for utility companies to make final readings

Notify the paperboy, cancel the newspaper

Locate the nearest hospital, drug store, physician, dentist and veterinarian in your new neighborhood

Make a list of important numbers you will need when you arrive



One Week Before You Move

Begin packing suitcases with items you will not need until after the move

Pack and label box with necessities you will need immediately such as:
Soap, towels, tissue, paper plates, cups, can opener, pet food, etc.

Set aside items you will take in the car

If your home is left vacant, notify police

One Day Before You Move

Empty and defrost the refrigerator and freezer and clean

Finish packing personal belongings

Moving Day

Supervise movers

Strip beds and leave fitted sheet on for protection

Make sure before you leave that everything has been moved,
appliances have been turned off and the house is locked up

Move-In Day

Tell movers where to place the furniture and have a check or cash to pay movers
